1 Introduction

As part of the activities and services of MoFiCo B.V., FibrXL Group B.V., FibrXL MidCo B.V. and their direct or indirect subsidiaries (a list of all FibrXL group entities is attached as Annex I) (hereinafter: '**FibrXL Group**', '**we**' or '**us**'), uses cookies on its website. Based on applicable legislation, especially section 11.7a of the Dutch Telecommunications Act (the **DTA**), we are obliged to inform you about the use of cookies on our website(s). Therefore, in this cookie notice we will inform you about the use of cookies on our website(s). In this cookie notice you will find the following information.

2 What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a website stores on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. They help the website remember information about your visit, which can both make it easier to visit the site again and make the site more useful to you. Data stored in a cookie is created by the server upon your connection. This data is labelled with an ID unique to you and your computer or mobile device. When the cookie is exchanged between your computer and the network server, the server reads the ID and knows what information to specifically serve to you. Cookies are stored on your device locally.

Websites use cookies to streamline your web experiences. Without cookies, for example, you have to login again after you leave a site or rebuild your shopping cart if you accidentally close the page. Making cookies an important part of the internet experience. Cookies can serve different purposes:

- (a) **Session management** – for example, cookies let websites recognize users and recall their individual login information and preferences, such as sports news versus politics.
- (b) **Personalization** – customized advertising is the main way cookies are used to personalize your sessions. You may view certain items or parts of a site, and cookies use this data to help build targeted ads that you might enjoy.

- (c) **Tracking** – cookies track individual browsing behavior and compile profiles, for example: shopping sites use cookies to track items users previously viewed, allowing the sites to suggest other goods they might like and keep items in shopping carts while they continue shopping.

Cookies can also be used to establish (anonymized) statistics about the browsing experience on websites.

There are different types of cookies.

- (a) **Session cookies** are used only while navigating a website. They are stored in random access on your computer or mobile device memory, are never written to the hard drive, and are deleted when you quit your browser. When the session ends, session cookies are automatically deleted.
- (b) **Persistent cookies** remain on your computer or mobile device indefinitely, although many include an expiration date and are automatically removed when that date is reached. But these are not deleted automatically when you quit your browser.
- (c) **First party cookies** are cookies set by the website you are visiting or using. Only that website can read them.
- (d) **Third-party cookies**, a website might potentially use external services, which also set their own cookies, these are known as third-party cookies. Another website (then the one you are visiting or using) manages these cookies and can read them.

Every time you visit our website(s), you will be prompted to accept or refuse cookies.

3 How do we use cookies and for which cookies do we need consent?

Our website mostly uses “first-party cookies”. These are cookies set and controlled by us, not by any external organization. Cookies that have no or little impact on your privacy do not require your consent. However, we must always ask your consent to set cookies that impact your privacy. These three types of first-party cookie we use are:

- (a) **Analytical**– we use analytical cookies to keep track of visitor statistics. This gives us a better understanding of how our website works and enables us to deliver a better user experience for our website visitors. Analytical cookies that are installed on a privacy friendly manner have hardly any impact on your privacy, therefore most of the time we do not need you consent to install these cookies.
- (b) **Functional cookies** - Functional cookies are necessary for our website to function. Without functional cookies in our website, our website would not function properly. Functional cookies have hardly any impact on your privacy, therefore most of the time we do not need your consent to install these cookies.
- (c) **Tracking cookies** – with these cookies we track individual browsing behavior and compile profiles. Because these cookies track individual browsing behavior and compile profiles to enable targeted ads, they have an impact on your privacy, therefore your consent is required.

If any kind of placement of cookies is based on your consent, we hereby inform you that you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of placement of cookies based on

consent before its withdrawal. You should note that certain parts of our website may not function or may no longer function optimally if you withdraw your consent or block certain cookies.

4 Which cookies do we use?

4.1 Analytical cookies - on our website we use the following analytical cookies.

5 Third party cookies

Some of our pages display content from external providers, e.g. YouTube, Facebook and Twitter. To view this third-party content, you first have to accept their specific terms and conditions. This includes their cookie policies, which we have no control over. But if you do not view this content, no third-party cookies are installed on your device. The following third parties may place cookies via our website(s):

- (a) Youtube

These third-party services are outside our control. Providers may, at any time, change their terms of service, purpose and use of cookies, etc. Therefore, we advise you to always check the website of the respective third-party cookie provider if you require any information on the use of their cookies.

6 How can you manage cookies?

Removing cookies from your device

You can delete all cookies that are already on your device by clearing the browsing history of your browser's data. This will remove all cookies from all websites you have visited. Be aware though that you may also lose some saved information (e.g. saved login details, site preferences, etc.).

Managing site-specific cookies

For more detailed control over site-specific cookies, check the privacy and cookie settings in your preferred browser.

Blocking cookies

You can set most modern browsers to prevent any cookies being placed on your device, but you may then have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit a website/page. Additionally, some services and functionalities may not work properly at all (e.g., profile logging-in).

7 Processing of personal data

In some cases, our cookies process personal data. In that case, we are obliged to comply with the General Data Protection Regulation (the **GDPR**), and local GDPR implementation legislation as well, and we are the controller for the processing of personal data by the cookies we install. In the section 'Which cookies do we use?' above we have explained which types of cookies process your personal data.

Where our cookies process your personal data, this cookie notice complements our privacy notice. Where personal data are processed in the context of our website, this cookie notice should be read in conjunction with our privacy notice.
